Committee Vote: Favorable, 8-0 (In favor: Council Members Hawkins, Davis, Dernoga, Harrison, Ivey, Streeter, Taveras and Turner)

The County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, convened on May 24, 2021 to consider CR-47-2021. The Planning, Housing and Economic Development Committee Director summarized the purpose of the resolution. CR-47-2021 provides for a transfer of certain appropriations and expenditures between certain programs in the FY 2020-2021 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) Operating Budget for the Recreation Fund. This Resolution provides for the transfer of \$25,000 from the Prince George's Youth Lacrosse program to the Kettering-Largo-Mitchellville Boys and Girls Club (\$10,000), Forestville Boys and Girls Club of Prince George's County, Inc. (\$10,000), and the Student Athletes for Educational Opportunities (SAFE0), Inc. (\$5,000), respectively. In addition, the Resolution provides for the transfer of \$7,500 from the College Park Boys and Girls Club to the Laurel Boys and Girls Club (\$5,000) and Laurel Historical Society (\$2,500), respectively. Finally, this Resolution will authorize the transfer of program funds in the amount of \$10,000 from the Maryland Cheer Chargers to Student Athletes for Educational Opportunities (SAFE0), Inc. This results in no change to the total expenditures approved within the Recreation Fund of the Fiscal Year 2020-21 budget.

On a motion by Council Member Davis and second by Council Member Harrison, the Committee of the Whole voted favorable on CR-47-2021 as drafted.
