10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Section 16-225.01 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
12 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

13 **SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.**

14 **DIVISION 17. LEAVE.**

15 **Sec. 16-225.01. Parental, family, and medical leave.**

16 (a) Parental leave. Up to [five (5) days] eight (8) weeks of paid parental leave shall be granted
17 to employees who are eligible for family and medical leave pursuant to this Section.

19 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
20 calendar days after it becomes law.
