CHARTER AMENDMENT

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Amendment of Section 814, Charter of Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of proposing an amendment to Section 814 of the Charter of Prince George's
4 County to provide an approval process for certain intrafund transfers of appropriations within
5 County agencies.

6 BY proposing an amendment to:

7 Section 814,

8 Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
10 Maryland, that the following amendment to Section 814, Charter of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, is hereby proposed:

12 **Sec. 814. Transfers of Appropriations.**

13 Transfers of appropriations between general classifications of expenditures in the current
14 expense budget within the same agency and within the same fund may be authorized by the
15 County Executive ; provided, however, that transfers exceeding a \$250,000.00 aggregate, or such
16 other sum as may be set by legislative act, in one fiscal year may be made on the
17 recommendation of the County Executive with the approval of the County Council. Transfers
18 between agencies of the County government and within the same fund of the current expense
19 budget may be made on the recommendation of the County Executive and with the approval of
20 the Council. Interproject transfers of appropriations between capital projects in the capital
21 budget may be authorized by legislative act of the Council upon request of the County Executive,

but no new project shall be created nor any abandoned except in accordance with Section 818 and Section 820 of this Charter. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to prevent the Council, upon request of the County Executive, from providing by law for interfund cash borrowings to meet temporary cash requirements nor to prevent reimbursements among funds for services rendered.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act be transmitted to the County Executive for publication and that a copy also be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors of Elections for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters of this County at the 2006 General Election pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the question of adoption of this proposed Charter Amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the General Election occurring on November 7, 2006, and shall be placed on the ballot in the following form:

PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

To provide an approval process for certain intrafund transfers of appropriations within County agencies.

Adopted this 10th day of August, 2006, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the full County Council.
