RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Joint Land Use Study

3 For the purpose of extending the time for implementation and support for the 2009 Joint Base
4 Andrews Naval Air Facility Washington Joint Land Use Study ('JLUS') recommendations
5 through the JLUS implementation Committee, extending the time for the JLUS Implementation
6 Committee report, amending the membership of the committee and providing for reappointment
7 of the Chair/Vice Chair of the JLUS Implementation Committee.

8 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council continues to recognize the importance
9 of Joint Base Andrews Naval Air Facility Washington to the local and regional economy, and
10 thus the need to protect its operational mission and capacity; and

11 WHEREAS, it is recognized that it is the responsibility of the local government to protect
12 public health, safety, and welfare by preparing a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS); and

13 WHEREAS, the JLUS Policy and Technical Committees worked together with Joint
14 Base Andrews over the course of fourteen months to develop the JLUS; and

15 WHEREAS, the JLUS contains recommendations for actions that will ensure compatible
16 development adjacent to Joint Base Andrews; and

17 WHEREAS, by adoption of CR-30-2010 on March 30, 2010, the Prince George's County
18 Council established the JLUS Implementation Committee to support the recommendations of the
19 2009 *Joint Base Andrews Naval Air Facility Washington Joint Land Use Study* (JLUS); and

20 WHEREAS, the terms of CR-30-2010 provided a term of five (5) years to perform its
21 functions; and

1 WHEREAS, there is a need to expand the membership of the JLUS Implementation Committee
2 and provide additional time for the Committee to complete its duties and responsibilities; and

3 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council may appoint, for
4 designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the county who shall
5 assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Prince George's County Council
7 hereby extends the term of the JLUS Implementation Committee until March 30, 2016, in order
8 to complete its duties in providing oversight, direction, and assistance to obtain necessary
9 resources to implement the recommendations of the 2009 *Joint Base Andrews Naval Air Facility*
10 *Washington JLUS*.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the JLUS Implementation Committee shall be
12 composed of nineteen (19) members, to include local, state, and federal elected and/or appointed
13 officials, and the following representatives:

- 14 1) Four representatives of the Prince George's County Council;
- 15 2) A representative of the Office of the County Executive;
- 16 3) A representative of the Prince George's County Planning Board;
- 17 4) A representative of the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation;
- 18 5) A representative of the United States Department of Defense;
- 19 6) A representative from the leadership of Joint Base Andrews;
- 20 7) A representative of the Maryland Department of Business & Economic Development,
21 Office of Military and Federal Affairs;
- 22 8) A representative of a business, trade or commercial organization;
- 23 9) A representative of the business industry;
- 24 10) A representative of the development industry;
- 25 11) A representative from a civic or community association located north of Joint Base
26 Andrews;
- 27 12) A representative from a civic or community association located south of Joint Base
28 Andrews;
- 29 13) A representative from the United States Congress;
- 30 14) A representative from the Maryland State General Assembly;
- 31 15) A representative from the faith community; and

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16) A representative from the general public residing within Central Prince George’s County.
The Chair/Vice Chair shall be appointed by the County Council for a three-year term, subject to reappointment to one year terms of service. Accordingly, the current Chair/Vice Chair of the JLUS Implementation Committee shall be re-appointed for a one-year term.
The term of service for Committee members shall be two years, subject to reappointment to one-year terms of service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George’s County Planning Department of The Maryland-National Park and Planning Commission is directed to provide appropriate staff assistance to the Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the JLUS Implementation Committee shall provide an annual report to the Prince George’s County Council of the committee’s activities and accomplishments.
