WHEREAS, the	County has adopted the practice of recognizing on dedication plaques the	
names of individuals,	groups, elected and appointed officials for their efforts, significant	
contributions and publ	ic service in providing new and/or improved County facilities to the	
public; and		
WHEREAS, the	County wishes to continue to have dedication plaques installed on new	
construction projects and improved or renovated County facilities giving the names of persons		
serving at the time of o	dedication; and	
WHEREAS, thro	bughout the County there are several County facilities and buildings that	
contain dedication plaques with inconsistent language and varying styles; and		
WHEREAS, then	e is a desire to provide uniformity and consistency in the dedication	
plaques that are placed	on County facilities and buildings including libraries, schools, public	
safety facilities, comm	unity centers, and other public facilities where substantial County revenue	
has been expended on	the facility; and	
WHEREAS, ther	re is not currently a County policy in place to address the issue of the	
language and style of dedication plagues and such a need does exist.		

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Prince George's County shall place the following information on

dedication plaques installed on public safety facilities, libraries, schools, community centers, and

1	any other County buildings:		
2	a)	The name of the building/facility;	
3	b)	Dedication date;	
4	c)	Name of the County Executive;	
5	d)	Names of the County Council Members;	
6	e)	Names of the Board Members/Trustees, if applicable;	
7	f)	Name of the Director/Superintendant, if applicable;	
8	g)	Name of the architect; and	
9	h)	Name of the contractor.	
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County shall install dedication plaques with a		
11	minimum size of 24" x 30", with leather texture, a single line border, and artistic bronze		
12	rendering.
