RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Dedication Plaques

3 For the purpose of establishing the County's policy on dedication plaques placed on County
4 facilities and buildings.

5 WHEREAS, the County has adopted the practice of recognizing on dedication plaques the
6 names of individuals, groups, elected and appointed officials for their efforts, significant
7 contributions and public service in providing new and/or improved County facilities to the
8 public; and

9 WHEREAS, the County wishes to continue to have dedication plaques installed on new
10 construction projects and improved or renovated County facilities giving the names of persons
11 serving at the time of dedication; and

12 WHEREAS, throughout the County there are several County facilities and buildings that
13 contain dedication plaques with inconsistent language and varying styles; and

14 WHEREAS, there is a desire to provide uniformity and consistency in the dedication
15 plaques that are placed on County facilities and buildings including libraries, schools, public
16 safety facilities, community centers, and other public facilities where substantial County revenue
17 has been expended on the facility; and

18 WHEREAS, there is not currently a County policy in place to address the issue of the
19 language and style of dedication plaques and such a need does exist.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
21 County, Maryland, that Prince George's County shall place the following information on
22 dedication plaques installed on public safety facilities, libraries, schools, community centers, and

1 any other County buildings:

- 2 a) The name of the building/facility;
- 3 b) Dedication date;
- 4 c) Name of the County Executive;
- 5 d) Names of the County Council Members;
- 6 e) Names of the Board Members/Trustees, if applicable;
- 7 f) Name of the Director/Superintendent, if applicable;
- 8 g) Name of the architect; and
- 9 h) Name of the contractor.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County shall install dedication plaques with a
11 minimum size of 24" x 30", with leather texture, a single line border, and artistic bronze
12 rendering.
