CHARTER AMENDMENT

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Amendment of Section 815, Charter of Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of proposing an amendment to Section 815 of the Charter of Prince George's
4 County to provide that during any fiscal year, no agency of County government may exceed the
5 number of positions for that agency as approved in the operating budget without the prior
6 approval of the Council.

7 BY proposing an amendment to:

8 Section 815,

9 Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that the following amendment to Section 815, Charter of Prince George's County,
12 Maryland, is hereby proposed:

13 **Section 815. Supplementary Appropriations; Staffing Level Increases.**

14 (a) During any fiscal year, the Council, upon recommendation of the County Executive,
15 may, by resolution, make additional or supplementary appropriations from unexpended and
16 unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget, and from Federal, State or
17 private grants which were not included in the budget for the current fiscal year, and may, by
18 legislative act, make additional or supplementary appropriations from revenue received from
19 anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates therefor, from revenues received from
20 sources not anticipated in the budget for the current fiscal year and from any prior year available
21 and uncommitted fund balance.

1 (b) During any fiscal year, no agency of County government may exceed the number of
2 positions [in each grade] for that agency as approved in the operating budget without the prior
3 approval of the Council.

4 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act be transmitted to the
5 County Executive for publication and that a copy also be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors
6 of Elections for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters of this County at the 2018
7 General Election pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter.

8 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the question of adoption of this proposed
9 Charter Amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the General Election
10 occurring on November 6, 2018, and shall be placed on the ballot in the following form:

12 PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

13 To provide that during any fiscal year, no agency of County government
14 may exceed the number of positions for that agency as approved in the
15 operating budget without the prior approval of the Council.
