Committee Report

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Wineland,

Castaldi, Del Giudice, Fletcher and MacKinnon)

The County is presently utilizing the past (1987) Edition of the National Electrical Code. The legislation has already had extensive review by a number of organizations. Among those are the National Electrical Contractors Association, the Independent Electrical Contractors Association, the Master Electricians and Electrical Contractors Association, the Suburban Maryland Building Industry Association and the County's Board of Registration for Master Electricians and Electrical Contractors.

This legislation will keep Prince George's County in step with other jurisdictions that have already adopted the 1990 National Electrical Code.

The service charges for permits, licenses and fees usually equals the enforcement and/or implementing cost, therefore the adoption of CB-99-1991 should not result in a negative fiscal impact on the County.
