BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed legislation is comprised of existing protections from the Personnel Law known as "prohibited personnel practices" combined with new provisions based upon "trial board" protections derived from the Maryland Law Enforcement Officer's Bill of Rights. The legislation provides specific prohibitions to protect employee's First Amendment rights and sanctions against persons who violate an employee's rights granted in the legislation.
