Remarks:

This legislation requires that notice of application for building and use and occupancy permits for commercial and industrial uses within municipalities be provided to the municipality.

Council Member Scott, the sponsor, presented a list of comments and indications of support for the legislation from individual municipalities.

Jimi Jones, representing the Planning Department, expressed concern about the number of potential appeals from the approximately 12,000 permits processed annually by the Planning Department. He recommended that a monthly list of permit applications be sent in lieu of individual notifications to municipalities.

Chris Pouler, representing the Prince George's County Municipal Association, expressed the PGCMA's support for the legislation.

The staff indicated two typographical errors which will be corrected in the final adopted draft.
