RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee

3 For the purpose of establishing the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee to provide continuing
4 oversight and support of the Food Truck Hub Program created by CB-16-2015 and CB-17-2015.

5 WHEREAS, the Food Truck Hub Program was created to increase access to healthy food
6 options for residents and employees, to better-serve food deserts and underserved areas, to create
7 an opportunity for entrepreneurship, and to spur innovation and redevelopment; and

8 WHEREAS, in order to ensure that the Food Truck Hub will continue in furtherance of the
9 specific provisions of CB-16-2015 and CB-17-2015 as well the above referenced goals; and

10 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council may appoint, for
11 designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall
12 assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
14 County, Maryland, that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee is hereby established to
15 provide continuing oversight and support of the Food Truck Hub Program created by
16 CB-16-2015 and CB-17-2015.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee shall be
18 composed of the following members:

- 19 1. President of the Prince George’s Economic Development Corporation or the
20 President’s representative, who shall serve as the presiding officer;
- 21 2. A representative designated by the Prince George’s Food Equity Council;
- 22 3. A representative designated by the Prince George’s County Social Innovation

- Fund;
- 4. A representative designated by the Prince George’s County Executive;
- 5. A representative designated by the Prince George’s County Chamber of Commerce;
- 6. A representative designated by Prince George’s Community College Center for Entrepreneurial Development;
- 7. A representative from the Food Truck industry as selected by the presiding officer of the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee;
- 8. Additional individuals as the presiding officer of the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee sees fit.
- 9. A representative designated by the Prince George’s County Health Department.
- 10. A representative designated by the Prince George’s County Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement.
- 11. A representative designated by the Restaurant Association of Maryland who operates in Prince George’s County.
- 12. A representative designated by the Revenue Authority of Prince George’s County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee shall meet in public session on call of the chairman at least quarterly; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee shall assist with the implementation of legislation and review and make recommendations to ensure the success of Food Truck Hubs in the County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee shall review the healthiness of food options provided in Food Truck Hubs, make recommendations and develop guidelines for enhancing healthy options at Food Truck Hubs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee shall report on its activities to the County Executive and County Council, and make a summary available to the general public; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator shall assign appropriate technical and administrative personnel to assist the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee in its work; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County,

1 Maryland, that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee is hereby created under the direction
2 of the County Council effective through two years from the date of adoption and shall be
3 reconvened thereafter as needed to continue the charge of the Food Truck Hub Oversight
4 Committee.
