an opportunity fo	or entrepreneurship, and to spur innovation and redevelopment; and
WHEREAS	S, in order to ensure that the Food Truck Hub will continue in furtherance of the
specific provisio	ns of CB-16-2015 and CB-17-2015 as well the above referenced goals; and
WHEREAS	S, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council may appoint, for
designated perio	ds, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall
assist in the cons	sideration of County policies and programs.

County, Marylar	nd, that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee is hereby established to
provide continui	ng oversight and support of the Food Truck Hub Program created by

- 8. Additional individuals as the presiding officer of the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee sees fit.
- 9. A representative designated by the Prince George's County Health Department.
- 10. A representative designated by the Prince George's County Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement.
- 11. A representative designated by the Restaurant Association of Maryland who operates in Prince George's County.
- 12. A representative designated by the Revenue Authority of Prince George's County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee shall meet in public session on call of the chairman at least quarterly; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee shall assist with the implementation of legislation and review and make recommendations to ensure the success of Food Truck Hubs in the County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee shall review the healthiness of food options provided in Food Truck Hubs, make recommendations and develop guidelines for enhancing healthy options at Food Truck Hubs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee shall report on its activities to the County Executive and County Council, and make a summary available to the general public; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator shall assign appropriate technical and administrative personnel to assist the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee in its work; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County,

1	Maryland, that the Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee is hereby created under the direction		
2	of the County Council effective through two years from the date of adoption and shall be		
3	reconvened thereafter as needed to continue the charge of the Food Truck Hub Oversight
