RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

The Historic Sites and Districts Plan (1991)

FOR the purpose of approving the 1991 amendment to the County's functional master plan for historic preservation, which establishes policies relating to the preservation, protection, and enhancement of identified structures, sites, and districts of historical, architectural, archeological, or cultural value.

WHEREAS, the County Council of Prince George's County, sitting as the District Council, and the Prince George's County

Planning Board held a duly advertised public hearing on May 21, 1991, on the Preliminary Amendment to the Historic Sites and Districts Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Preliminary Amendment to the Historic Sites and Districts Plan, consisting of a map and text, is considered to be an updating of the 1981 Historic Sites and Districts Plan, the Prince George's County General Plan (1982), and all Area Master Plans approved prior to the adoption date of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board held a worksession on October 31, 1991, and subsequently the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission adopted the Plan on November 14, 1991; and

WHEREAS, the District Council held a worksession on February 18, 1992, to review public hearing testimony on the Plan and the recommendations of the Planning Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, that the Preliminary Amendment to the Historic Sites and Districts Plan, as adopted by the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission on November 14, 1991, is hereby approved with the following amendments:

1. An environmental setting for Brown's Tavern (Historic Site #66-1) shall encompass the tavern and approximately one-half acre of grounds, including the
