Preparation of a new Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) and approval of goals,		
concepts, guide	lines, and public participation program for the Metro Green Line Corridor area,	
	part of Planning Areas 75A and 76A	
For the purpose of initiating a Sector Plan and concurrent Sectional Map Amendment for the		
four stations along the Metro Green Line and adjacent communities in southern Prince George's		
County, and approving goals, concepts, guidelines, and a public participation program in order to		
develop a comprehensive approach to implement and/or update the recommendations of the		
Master Plan and Sectional Map Amendment for the Heights and Vicinity (2000); Suitland Mixed-		
Use Town Center Development Plan (2006); Branch Avenue Corridor Sector Plan and Sectional		
Map Amendment (2008); and, the Subregion 4 Master Plan and Sectional Map Amendment		
(2010) to ensure that future development is consistent with County policies.		
WHEREAS	, the Sector Plan area follows and surrounds the alignment of the southern	
portion of the Me	etrorail Green Line in Prince George's County and is roughly defined by	
Southern Avenue	as a western boundary, Suitland Road as a northern boundary, Interstate I-495	
(the "Capital Bel	tway") as the eastern boundary, and Branch Avenue as the southern boundary;	
as shown in the Sector Plan boundary map included within Attachment A; and		
WHEREAS	, the Prince George's County Planning Department of the Maryland-National	
Capital Park and Planning Commission, on behalf of Prince George's County, applied for and		
received a grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") under		

the 2010 Community Challenge Planning Grant program of the Office of Sustainable Housing

and Communities to fund preparation of an action plan to promote and facilitate transit-oriented development along the southern Metro Green Line corridor; and

WHEREAS, HUD requires that the approved Sector Plan incorporate and seek to achieve the following Livability Principles established by the Federal Partnership for Sustainable Communities: provide more transportation choices; promote equitable, affordable housing; enhance economic competitiveness; support existing communities; coordinate and leverage federal policies and investment; and, value communities and neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Sector Plan will approve development policy and guidelines to provide a mix of uses at an intensity appropriate for land within the Developed Tier, as articulated in the 2002 *Approved Prince George's County General Plan*; and

WHEREAS, Sections 27-225.01.05 and 27-641 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County establish procedures whereby the Prince George's County Planning Board may initiate a Sector Plan and a concurrent SMA with the concurrence of the District Council; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the District Council to process the Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment concurrently, in accordance with Section 27-225.01.05 of the Zoning Ordinance, to provide a strong interrelationship between land use recommendations in approved plans and zoning of land; and

WHEREAS, preparation of the Sector Plan for the Metro Green Line Corridor will involve coordination with all levels of government, including federal, state, county, and regional agencies on issues pertinent to the project, and requires coordination with and review by HUD of technical reports, outreach materials, and work programs associated with the planning process, the Planning Board is requesting a two-month extension of the eight (8) months scheduled to prepare the preliminary plan document; and

WHEREAS, the Goals, Concepts, Guidelines, and Public Participation Program (Attachment A), attached hereto and incorporated as if set forth fully herein establishes the purpose of the planning project, the issues to be addressed during plan preparation, and a methodology for ensuring adequate community involvement throughout the planning process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a Sector Plan and concurrent

1	Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) for the Metro Green Line Corridor in accordance with the
2	requirements of Parts 3 and 13 of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County, Maryland.
3	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Goals, Concepts, Guidelines and Public
4	Participation Program (Attachment A) attached hereto and incorporated as it set forth fully
5	herein be and the same are hereby approved.
6	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Council hereby approves a two-month
7	extension of the plan preparation schedule, as provided in Section 27-644.
8	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
