

A Comprehensive Approach

- Team Based Care Model
 - Pharmacists, Nurses, Social Workers, Community Health Workers,
 Nutrition & Diabetes Educators and Advanced Medical Assistants
- Comprehensive Testing Services: A1C, Spirometry, Cognitive Screening, Retinopathy Screening, & Cardiac Evaluations
- Same-Day Appointment Availability

Health Risks in Prince George's County

Asthma, Obesity, & Substance Abuse impacted by SDoH

Targeted Programs:

- Obesity: Expand health education and wellness initiatives, with increased access to weight management programs through primary care and Lanham Bariatrics
- Asthma: Launch program with remote monitoring, community-based medication, enhanced telemedicine, and pharmacy delivery to reduce ED visits.
- Substance Use: Optimize Utilization of Behavioral Health services in Prince George's County; integrate protocol-driven PSA treatment into Primary Care
- Diabetes: Leverage current resources to expand evidence-based, teambased, protocol-driven care → increase access, control, and prevention

Preventative Medicine for Community Wellness



EPIC EHR (HIMMS Stage 7) with CRISP integration + SDoH platform, creating a single source of community health record



Data-Drive Primary Care: close care gaps, manage chronic illness & support transitions of care



Remote Patient Monitoring: expand chronic disease management capabilities



Health Equity in Screening: scale prostate cancer equity model to address other disparities



Faith-Based Partnerships: immunization, screening and education to build on Covid & diabetes program success

Diabetes Prevention

- Hemoglobin A1C < 8%:72.3%
- Blood Pressure Control: 82.1%



Hypertension

Cancer Screenings

- Colorectal Cancer Screening:

Investments Required to Actualize Expanded Primary Care

Considerable investments will be required to impact the healthcare gaps and disparities across the service area, which can be accelerated with the County's support and partnership.
