LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

PLANNING AND ZONING COMMITTEE REPORT DATE: 9/23/91

Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Casula,

Castaldi, Fletcher and Bell)

Staff explained that this legislation allows the Board of Administrative Appeals to hear appeals regarding Stormwater Management decisions, allows the Board to meet only when necessary, rather than twice monthly, and deletes the requirement that meetings must be recorded by a reporter, and requires simply that they be recorded.
