RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Economic Development Week

3 For the purpose of expressing Prince George’s County’s support for declaring the week of
4 September 19 – September 23 as Economic Development Week in Prince George’s County.

5 WHEREAS, Prince George’s County’s Economic Development Corporation, FSC First,
6 and the Conference and Visitors Bureau are active members of the Maryland Economic
7 Development Association (MEDA), a non-profit organization established in 1961 whose mission
8 is to enhance the knowledge and skills of its members, encourage partnerships and networking
9 among people committed to bringing jobs and capital to Maryland, and promote economic
10 development as an investment in Maryland; and

11 WHEREAS, MEDA members, and all of those involved in economic development in both
12 the public and private sectors, promote the economic well-being of Maryland by working to
13 improve the State’s business climate and the professionalism of those in the field of economic
14 development; and

15 WHEREAS, Prince George’s County is an important component of the State of Maryland’s
16 economic success, and all regions and jurisdictions in Maryland have a stake in Prince George’s
17 County’s ability to grow its commercial tax base and attract and retain jobs; and

18 WHEREAS, a strong, professional economic development team is vital to that success, and
19 the men and women who work daily to bring jobs and commercial development to Prince
20 George’s County and to the State of Maryland deserve both thanks and recognition for their
21 efforts; and

22 WHEREAS, the economic growth and stability of the State of Maryland affects all regions

1 and jurisdictions within Maryland, and Prince George’s County’s Economic Development
2 Corporation, FSC First, and the Conference and Visitors Bureau are important components of the
3 Maryland’s economic success, and will highlight those successes by various events and
4 announcements during Economic Development;

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's
6 County, joined by the County Executive, hereby supports and proclaims the week of September
7 19 – September 23 as Economic Development Week in Prince George’s County, and asks
