| WHEREAS | S, the County Council fully understands the importance of issues surrounding the | |
| fiscal stability of | the Dimensions Healthcare System, Inc. (Dimensions Healthcare) and the | |

| WHERE | AS, the County Council must exercise the fiduciary responsibilities assigned to | |

| WHEREAS, the County Council also serves as the Board of Health with an obligation to | | |
| establish and monitor health policies in the County; and | | |
| WHERE | AS, on November 25, 2003, the County Council, in partnership with the County | |
| Executive, enacted CB-98-2003, to provide for an immediate cash infusion of \$5 Million to | | |
| stabilize the fiscal situation of Dimensions Healthcare and stands ready, as an essential and | | |
| critical member of the Dimensions Healthcare "turnaround team," and a co-equal branch of | | |
| government, to c | ontinue an active and appropriate role in planning, funding, and overseeing | |

| WHEREAS, Maryland Governor Robert L. Ehrlich, Jr. and County Executive Jack B | | |
| Johnson have ne | gotiated and executed a Memorandum of Understanding to formulate a Financial | |
| Action Plan and to provide for an additional layer of oversight for Dimensions Healthcare in an | | |

effort to preserve the financially strapped Prince George's Hospital Center; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has regrettably not been afforded an opportunity to participate in the formation of the Memorandum of Understanding and the Financial Action Plan and based upon understanding of the agreement obtained from several different sources, has identified several specific issues of concern to be addressed before the Council will consider additional funding requests for the benefit of Dimensions Healthcare; and

WHEREAS, any appropriation of funds contained in the agreement is subject to an affirming vote from the County Council for final approval; and

WHEREAS, the County Council is anxious to see the fiscal crisis affecting Dimensions Healthcare, which has negatively affected the public health, safety and welfare of our citizens, resolved in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the County Council encourages a timely resolution to the concerns of the Council prior to any request for further appropriations to be approved by the Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Executive is requested to provide the following information to the Council as soon as possible:

- A briefing regarding the budget implications of a \$10 million grant in the current fiscal year (FY'04), and a \$5 million grant over the next four Fiscal Years, Fy'05 '08 totaling \$20 million.
- The short term and long-term impact of such proposed expenditures upon the hospital system and its bond rating.
- The impact of such proposed expenditures upon other County priorities and the County's bond rating.
- Clarification regarding the reported obligation to provide \$10 million from County funds in FY 2004. The Council authorized a grant of \$5 million in CB-98-2003. The Council seeks clarification of the source of the additional funds and whether the additional \$5 million is a grant or a loan.
- A specified role for the County Council, beyond annual budget approval, as detailed in the agreement between the County and the State, including, but not limited to, provisions for the appointment of a representative of the Council's choosing to the oversight committee.
- Delineation of the Council's authority to conduct oversight, monitor, and/or ensure compliance, including access to the full, non-redacted interim reports and the complete Final

Recovery/Restructuring Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council, sitting as the Board of Health, will convene a meeting on Tuesday, March 9, 2004, at 10:30 a.m. to discuss with the County Executive or his representatives, the Governor or his representatives, the Dimensions Healthcare Board of Directors, and other experts, the issues set forth herein and other concerns related to the health of Dimensions Healthcare and the impact of the MOU between the County and the State on this system.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that absent satisfactory responses to the Council's concerns, the Council does not intend to authorize further appropriations for Dimensions Healthcare.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the County Council shall provide a copy of this resolution to the Governor, the County Executive, the Board of Directors of Dimensions Healthcare, Ernst & Young, the Chair of the Senate Budget & Taxation Committee, the Chairs of the House and Senate Delegations for the County, the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and the Chairman of the Health Services Cost Review Commission.
