The County Council convened in COW on April 30, 2024, to consider CR-39-2024. CR-39-2024 pertains to juvenile and minor curfew zones, aiming to grant the Police Chief authority to establish and enforce stricter curfew regulations in county zones. These measures are enacted at the request of commercial property owners under specific conditions.

Council Member Oriadha requested clarification on the necessity of the resolution (CR-39-2024), the bill (CB-29-2024), and the Executive Order.

Chair Ivey explained that we have legislation currently proceeding through the legislative process simultaneously: CR-39-2024 and CB-29-2024. The bill remains crucial, and our efforts will continue on CB-29-2024. Chair Ivey further stated that CR-39-2024 mirrors CB-29-2024.

The resolution addresses an immediate need. It's anticipated that the bill won't be fully enacted until the end of May, and there's a waiting period of 45 days for it to

become active due to non-emergency status. During this gap, the resolution will serve to address the current situation.

A motion was made by Council Member Franklin, seconded by Council Member Harrison, to move favorably on CR-39-2024.

After discussion, the County Council, sitting as the COW, voted 8-0-1 favorably on CR-39-2024.
