**PROPOSED DESIGNATION OF PROPERTY

Pursuant to provisions of the Land Use Article of the Maryland Annotated Code, as well as Subtitle 29 of the Prince George's County Code, the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council, and the Prince George's County Planning Board of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission hereby give notice of a joint public hearing to receive public testimony concerning the proposed designation of property in Prince George's County as Historic Sites, specifically five (5) properties located within the City of College Park, the City of Hyattsville, and the City of Bowie, as follows:

2. PG 68-010-87) Miller-Spicknall House, 4916 40th Place, Hyattsville
3. (PG 68-010-88) Harvey Dairy Store, 4214 Gallatin Street, Hyattsville
4. (PG 68-010-89) Jardella House, 4002 Crittenden Street, Hyattsville
5. (PG 71B-023) Frederick and Frances Watkins House, "Grovehurst," 14307 Delcastle Drive, Bowie

The purpose of the public hearing is to give property owners, affected municipalities, other stakeholders and interested persons the opportunity to express their views concerning the proposed historic site designations.
