Employ Prince George's & American Job Center National Harbor Programming

Employ Prince George's utilized VLT funding, along with other funding sources, to build and staff American Job Center National Harbor. From an architectural design, aesthetics, and technology standpoint, American Job Center National Harbor is seen as a national standard for American Job Centers across the United States.

Along with the construction of the center itself, VLT funding supports outreach and community engagement, partnership development, and workforce development programming for residents residing within the MGM Impact Area, including intensive services via one or more of Employ Prince George's 13 workforce development programs at American Job Center National Harbor.

Since the grand opening of American Job Center National Harbor, Employ Prince George's has provided intensive one-on-one career coaching, career readiness training, entrepreneurship training, financial literacy, supportive services, skills upgrading scholarships, long-term career pathways planning, and referrals to other entities and services that lead to training program completion and employment attainment.

Employ Prince George's Occupational Skills Training

Employ Prince George's, through VLT funding from the Local Development Council, provides intensive services to eligible Prince George's County residents residing in the MGM Impact Area. One of the intensive services offered is **Skills Upgrading Scholarships**. Skills upgrading scholarships pay for a participant's (adults ages 18+) tuition, books, uniforms, supplies, professional memberships, and credential exams. On average, Employ Prince George's pays an average of \$4,500 in skills upgrading scholarships per participant.

Through Employ Prince George's comprehensive workforce development service delivery model at American Job Center National Harbor, participants receiving intensive programmatic services at American Job Center National Harbor have been extremely successful in securing employment. See the results below.
