BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Civil Monetary Fines or Penalties—Zoning Violations—Schedule of Fines

3 For the purpose of amending schedule of civil monetary fines in the enforcement of certain
4 zoning violations related to illegal signs in Prince George’s County.

5 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

6 **SUBTITLE 28. CIVIL MONETARY FINES OR**
7 **PENALTIES.**

8 Section 28-111,
9 The Prince George's County Code
10 (2015 Edition).

11 **SECTION 1.** BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
12 Maryland, that Section 28-111 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
13 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

14 **SUBTITLE 28. CIVIL MONETARY FINES OR PENALTIES.**

15 **DIVISION 1. ZONING VIOLATIONS.**

16 **SUBDIVISION 2. CIVIL VIOLATIONS AND FINES.**

17 **Sec. 28-111. Schedule of civil monetary fines.**

18 (a) The civil monetary fine for each civil violation of the Zoning Ordinance shall be Two
19 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), except as provided in Subsections (b) and (c), below.

(b) For a repeated civil violation by the same violator, the following fines shall apply:

2nd violation	\$500.00
Each violation in excess of two (2)	\$1,000.00

(c) For violations of Sections 27-593, 27-609, or 27-610 of this Code concerning illegal signs, the following civil monetary fines shall apply:

1st violation	[\$100.00] <u>\$500.00</u>
2nd violation and subsequent violations	[\$500.00] <u>\$1,000.00</u>

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
