RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Work Group on Crime, Children and Safer Communities

3 For the purpose of extending the reporting date for the Work Group on Crime, Children and
 4 Safer Communities to make recommendations to the County Council.

5 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council on February 26, 2013 adopted CR-12-
 6 2013, establishing the Work Group on Crime, Children and Safer Communities, a thirteen (13)
 7 member group, to address the recent spike in youth violence and homicides in Prince George's
 8 County and recommend strategies and solutions that need to be implemented in order to enhance
 9 the safety and decrease the crime by and against the youth in our communities and provide its
 10 recommendations to the Council by September 30, 2013; and

11 WHEREAS, the Work Group on Crime, Children and Safer Communities desires additional
 12 time to examine the laws on truancy, create an environment of Zero Tolerance on gun violence
 13 in the County, explore the culpability of parents for the actions of their children, examine the
 14 effects of domestic violence on youth violence, review the recommendations of the Youth and
 15 Gang Violence Prevention Task Force and the Youth and Gang Violence Prevention Steering
 16 Committee, and to consider appropriate recommendations for implementation related thereto;
 17 and

18 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the County Council may appoint, for
 19 designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall
 20 assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
 22 County, Maryland, that the deadline is extended for the Work Group on Crime, Children and

1 Safer Communities to present its evaluation and recommendation to the County Council from
2 September 30, 2013 to March 31, 2014.
