For the purpose of	approving the Washington Suburban Transit Commission's administration of
the County's FY 2	003 Mass Transit Plan, approving the levy of property tax rates necessary to
support the expens	ses and obligations of the Commission including County mass transit
operations; and ap	proving the WSTC's administrative budget.
WHEREAS,	pursuant to Section 15 of the Washington Suburban Transit District Act the
Washington Subu	rban Transit Commission submitted a proposed budget for administrative
expenses to the Co	ounty Executives and County Councils of Montgomery and Prince George's
Counties; and	
WHEREAS,	in order to provide a more stable source of funding for mass transit programs,
the County develo	ped a Mass Transit Plan for Fiscal Year 2003 which has been approved by the
Washington Subu	rban Transit Commission; and
WHEREAS,	this Mass Transit Plan is supported in part by a direct property tax levy on all
taxable real and po	ersonal property in Prince George's County, pursuant to Section 14 of the
Washington Subu	rban Transit District Act, such tax rates to be certified by the Washington
Suburban Transit	Commission; and
WHEREAS,	the revenue generated from this transit tax, along with support for County
mass transit activi	ties from the Federal government, the State of Maryland and other sources will

WHEREAS, on May 9, 2002, the Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils

be administered by the Washington Suburban Transit Commission; and

1 jointly reviewed and concurred in the Washington Suburban Transit Commission's 2 administrative budget for Fiscal Year 2003. 3 SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince 4 George's County, Maryland, that there is hereby imposed and levied a tax of two and six tenths 5 cents (\$0.026) upon each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation of real property 6 and six and one half cents (\$0.065) upon each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed 7 valuation of personal property and operating real property described in Section 8-109 of the Tax-8 Property Article for transit purposes, assessed according to the Laws of Maryland and subject to 9 taxation in Prince George's County. SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the tax rates levied and imposed by this 10 11 resolution shall take effect and be in force for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending 12 June 30, 2003. 13 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Washington Suburban Transit 14 Commission's budget for Fiscal Year 2003 is approved in the amount of \$94,630,026 as 15 specified in the County's Mass Transit Plan. 16 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Washington Suburban Transit 17 Commission's administrative budget for Fiscal Year 2003 is approved in the amount of \$671,015 18 of which \$67,500 is the Prince George's County share of said budget.
