RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Blue Ribbon Commission on Addressing Prince George’s County’s
3 Structural Deficit

4 For the purpose of extending the reporting date for the Blue Ribbon Commission on Addressing
5 Prince George’s County’s Structural Deficit to make recommendations and submit a final report.

6 WHEREAS, the Prince George’s County Council on June 16, 2015 adopted CR-26-2015,
7 establishing the Blue Ribbon Commission on Addressing Prince George’s County’s Structural
8 Deficit (the “Commission”), a fifteen (15) member group to collect, review and discuss (i)
9 comparative budget data and information regarding Prince George’s County’s fiscal health and
10 similar jurisdictions, (ii) policies and practices that affect Prince George’s County’s revenue
11 structure and the strength of its tax base, (iii) the structure and fiscal dynamics of Prince
12 George’s County’s government, (iv) feedback from stakeholders in the community concerning
13 the County’s budget and tax structure, and (v) any other items which the County Council deems
14 appropriate and relevant and provide a final report by July 1, 2016; and

15 WHEREAS, the County Council desires to provide additional time to the Commission to
16 ensure that the Commission has the time it needs to process the significant amount of
17 information it has gathered, and host a third public hearing to receive additional feedback from
18 the community on this important issue; and

19 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the County Council may appoint, for
20 designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall
21 assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

1 County, Maryland, that the Commission’s original July 1, 2016 final report deadline is extended
2 for 120 days for submission on or before November 1, 2016.
