Section 2: Be it further resolved and ordained by the Council of the City of Glenarden that Chapter 149, "Traffic and Vehicles", Article V, §149-26 "Inoperative Vehicles" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Glenarden be repealed and re-enacted as follows:

§149-26 Inoperative Vehicles.

A. ****

B. The parking or storing of any inoperative vehicle which is dismantled, damaged, wrecked or unsightly, of every kind of description, upon residentially zoned property or any other property not zoned for such storage within the corporate limits of the City of Glenarden for a period of time longer than [72] 24 hours after said inoperative vehicle becomes dismantled, damaged, wrecked or unsightly, unless said vehicle is stored in an [and auto cover or] enclosed garage, is hereby prohibited.
