RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Formation of an Agricultural District pursuant to the

3 Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation Program

4 For the purpose of recommending that the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation
5 approve the petition of Hedy Pirner to establish an agricultural district.

6 WHEREAS, a petition filed on April 18, 2006, by Hedy Pirner requested the establishment
7 of an agricultural preservation district for approximately 84.5 acres of land located on the south
8 side of Horsehead Road in the Baden/Brandywine area, as generally shown on the attached
9 location map; and

10 WHEREAS, the petition was referred to the Prince George's County Agricultural
11 Preservation Advisory Board and the Prince George's County Planning Board for review and
12 recommendation; and

13 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board found
14 that the Hedy Pirner property met the qualifying criteria for productivity, size, and location as set
15 by the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation, and recommended establishment of
16 the agricultural district on April 25, 2006; and

17 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Planning Board found that the establishment of
18 the proposed agricultural district is compatible with existing and approved county plans and
19 recommended approval of the petition and establishment of the district on May 18, 2006.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
2 County, Maryland, that Parcels 16 and 17 described in the agricultural district petition filed by
3 Hedy Pirner are recommended to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation for
4 approval.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution, copies of the petition, and copies of the
6 letters from the Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board and the Prince George's County
7 Planning Board, be forwarded by the Clerk of the Council to the County Executive for his
8 consideration and, upon his approval, transmittal to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation
9 Foundation for appropriate action.
