TRANSPORTATION, HOUSING AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

Committee Vote: Favorable as Amended, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Harrington, Bland, Dernoga and Exum)

Staff summarized the purpose of the resolution. CR-76-2006 expresses the support of financing for the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development Neighborhood Business Development Program known as the Neighborhood Business Works Program.

Council Member Campos sponsored CR-76-2006, a resolution indicating the Council's support for CASA of Maryland, Inc., to apply for a grant from the State of Maryland. Mr. Campos expressed his support of CR-76-2006 and asked the Committee to vote favorable on this legislation.

The Office of Law determined that CR-76-2006 was in proper legislative form with additional technical amendments stating that "The technical amendments conform the proposed County legislation text with the text of §6-304 and §6-305 of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, regarding the Neighborhood Business Development Program." outlined in the Resolution as Draft 2.

The Office of Audits and Investigations indicated that the adoption of CR-76-2006 will not have any adverse fiscal impact on the County.

The County Executive staff had no comments on CR-76-2006.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

CASA of Maryland, Inc. (CASA), a nonprofit organization has applied for approximately \$75,000 in grant funding from the Neighborhood Business Works Program operated by the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development.
