BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

The Redevelopment Authority is proposing a \$42.1 million six-year capital improvement program, including five revitalization projects throughout the County. This resolution approves the proposed capital improvement program in the amount of \$14 million for three of the five projects (Gateway Arts District, Palmer Park Senior Village and Suitland Manor).

The Redevelopment Authority is required to submit its proposed operating budget to the Council for comments. This resolution states the Council's concurrence in the Authority's proposed FY 2003 operating budget of \$7,593,100.
