AN ORDINANCE concerning

Catering Businesses

FOR the purpose of permitting a catering business as a home occupation under certain circumstances.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince Geor

ge's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part

SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

PART 2. GENERAL.

DIVISION 1. DEFINITIONS.

Sec. 27-107.1. Definitions.

- (a) Terms in the Zoning Ordinance are defined as follows: (118) Home Occupation:
- (C) The following shall be considered home occupations:

* * * * * * * * * * * *

- (iv) The practice of electrolysis (the destruction of hair roots with an electric current); [and]
 - (v) The practice of taxidermy[.]; and
- (vi) Catering business, limited solely to food preparation for delivery off premises, which business shall be located on a tract consisting of at least ten (10) contiguous acres, within the dwelling unit or in an accessory building which is incidental and secondary in size and use to the principal use of the property as a residence and involving not more than one (1) nonresident or employee on the premises at any time.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect on December 31, 1991.
