A RESOLUTION concerning

The Formation of an Agricultural District pursuant to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation Program

For the purpose of recommending that the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation approve the petition of John P. and Donna L. Denison to establish an agricultural district.

WHEREAS, a petition filed on March 13, 2002 by John P. and Donna L. Denison requested the establishment of an agricultural preservation district for approximately 123 acres of land on the south side of Accokeek Road, approximately 0.8 mile west of Gardner Road, as generally shown on the attached location map; and

WHEREAS, the petition was referred to the Prince George's County Planning Board and the Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board for review and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Planning Board found that establishment of the proposed agricultural district is compatible with existing and approved county plans and recommended approval the petition and establishment of the district; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board found that the Denison property met the qualifying criteria for productivity, size, and location as set by the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation, and recommended establishment of the agricultural district; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the 123 acre tract described in the agricultural district petition filed by John P. and Donna L. Denison is recommended to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation
