- (G) A list containing the names and addresses of all adjoining property owners and the owners of those properties directly across a street, alley, or stream, and a set of preaddressed envelopes or mailing labels[.];
- (H) Supporting evidence which shows whether the proposed development will exceed the capacity of transportation facilities that are existing, are under construction, or for which one hundred percent (100%) of construction funds are allocated within the adopted County Capital Improvement Program and/or within the current State Consolidated Transportation Program;
- (I) Any other data or explanatory material deemed necessary by the District Council, Zoning Hearing Examiner, or the Planning Board (submitted in triplicate).
