For the purpose	of expressing the Prince George's County Council's support for condemning all
acts of violence	and human rights abuses against civilians in the Tigray Region of Ethiopia.
WHERE	AS, regarding the principles and provisions of international humanitarian law,
including the G	eneva Conventions of 1949 and their Additional Protocols, as well as the
Responsibility to	Protect (R2P) doctrine; and
WHERI	EAS, recognizing the ongoing humanitarian crisis in the Tigray region of
Ethiopia, charac	terized by widespread violence, displacement of populations, human rights
abuses, and seve	re food and medical shortages; and
WHER	REAS, emphasizing the urgent need to alleviate the suffering of the affected
population and a	ddress the dire humanitarian situation in Tigray; and
WHER	REAS, reaffirming the commitment to uphold human rights, ensure the protection
of civilians, and	guarantee unhindered access for humanitarian assistance in conflict-affected
areas; and	
WHEF	REAS, acknowledging the efforts made by international and regional
humanitarian org	ganizations, as well as non-governmental organizations, in providing assistance
to the affected pe	opulation in Tigray despite significant challenges; and

WHEREAS, noting with concern the reported obstacles and restrictions imposed on

humanitarian actors, hindering the delivery of life-saving aid, including arbitrary detentions,

denial of access, attacks on humanitarian personnel and assets, and other acts that impede the provision of assistance; and

WHEREAS, deeply concerned by the reports of widespread violence, including sexual and gender-based violence, forced displacement, extrajudicial killings, and other human rights violations committed against civilians in Tigray; and

WHEREAS, reiterating the importance of upholding the principles of impartiality, neutrality, and independence in humanitarian action while respecting the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ethiopia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Council hereby condemns all acts of violence, human rights abuses, and violations of international humanitarian law committed against civilians in the Tigray region; calls upon all parties involved in the conflict in Tigray to immediately cease hostilities, respect international humanitarian law, and take all necessary measures to ensure the protection of civilians; and urges the government of Ethiopia to collaborate with international and regional humanitarian organizations, as well as non-governmental organizations, to remove all obstacles and restrictions on the delivery of humanitarian assistance to Tigray and to facilitate safe and unhindered access for humanitarian actors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council hereby encourages the international community, regional organizations, and bilateral partners to provide financial, logistical, and technical support to enhance the capacity of humanitarian organizations operating in Tigray, enabling them to effectively address the urgent needs of the affected population; requests the United Nations, including the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA), to continue coordinating and mobilizing international humanitarian efforts, ensuring efficient distribution of aid, and monitoring the implementation of humanitarian programs in Tigray; calls upon all parties involved in the conflict to fully cooperate with relevant international and regional human rights mechanisms and grant them unrestricted access to investigate allegations of human rights abuses and violations in Tigray; requests to the United Nations Human Right Council to extend the mandate of the International Commission of Human Rights Experts on Ethiopia, which investigates the war crimes and the human rights violations that took place in the Tigray region of Ethiopia, for one year until December 2024 to ensure accountability for all those responsible

for human rights abuses and to facilitate the establishment of independent, impartial, and transparent mechanisms for the investigation and prosecution of such crimes; decides to remain actively seized of the matter and to monitor the situation in Tigray closely, including through regular reporting and review of progress made in implementing this resolution; encourages all relevant stakeholders to actively support national dialogue, reconciliation, and efforts towards sustainable peace in Tigray in order to address the root causes of the conflict and promote long-term stability; urges Member States and relevant stakeholders to provide support for the recovery and reconstruction of Tigray, with a particular focus on rehabilitating critical infrastructure, ensuring the provision of basic services, and facilitating the return and reintegration of displaced populations; and requests the Secretary-General of the United Nations to provide regular updates to the County Council on the progress made in implementing this resolution, including any challenges faced in ensuring unhindered humanitarian access to Tigray.
