Staff explained that the resolution approves an amendment to Chapter 74 of the Town of Landover Hills concerning fences. The Town adopted Ordinance 0-01-08 on February 19, 2008 for the purpose of setting standards for fences. Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland Annotated Code requires District Council approval of the Town's ordinance before it becomes effective.

Council Member Olson requested the committee's support of the resolution to allow the Town of Landover Hills' Ordinance to be effective.

The Office of Law reviewed CR-52-2008 and determined that it is in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption. The Office of Audits and Investigations determined that the adoption of CR-52-2008 will not have an adverse fiscal impact on the County.
