RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Stop Sign Monitoring Systems - City of Greenbelt

3 For the purpose of providing County Council approval of locations for stop sign monitoring
4 systems in the City of Greenbelt, and generally regarding stop sign monitoring systems.

5 WHEREAS, the City of Greenbelt seeks County Council approval for installing Stop Sign
6 Enforcement Cameras pursuant to the Md. Transportation Article, Sec. 21-707.1(c)(2)(i) and Sec
7 21-707.1(c)(2)(ii), and Prince George’s County Code, Sec 26-120.02(c)(2)(B) and Sec. 26-
8 120.02(c)(2)(C), and Attachment 2; and

9 WHEREAS, Md. Transportation Article, Sec 21-707.1(c)(2)(i) provides that an agency may
10 use stop sign monitoring systems on highways located in a school zone maintained by a local
11 jurisdiction, if authorized by the governing body of the local jurisdiction, Attachment 1- City of
12 Greenbelt Request Letter, Attachment 2- City of Greenbelt City Council Ordinance 1402,
13 Attachment 3 - City of Greenbelt City Council Resolution 2117, Attachment 4 - City Council
14 Work Session December 11, 2024, and Attachment 5 - City Council Agenda April 14, 2025; and

15 WHEREAS, Md. Transportation Article, Sec. 21-707.1(c)(2)(ii) provides that a stop sign
16 monitoring system may only be used at a location approved by the Prince George’s County
17 Council; and

18 WHEREAS, Prince George’s County Code, Sec. 26-120.02(c)(2)(B) provides that stop sign
19 monitoring systems may only be used at a location approved by the Prince George’s County
20 Council and Sec. 26-120.02(c)(2)(C) provides that Council approval of the location of stop sign
21 monitoring systems used by municipalities shall be made by Council resolution upon receipt of a

1 letter requesting such approval; and

2 WHEREAS, the County Council is in receipt of the City of Greenbelt’s request letter,
3 Attachment 1, and supporting documents, including traffic violation data from high-risk
4 intersections near school zones, demonstrating a critical need for automated enforcement; and

5 WHEREAS the City of Greenbelt’s Police Department documented numerous stop sign
6 violations.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
8 County, Maryland, that the County Council hereby approves the locations for stop sign
9 monitoring systems for the City of Greenbelt, as set forth in Attachment 1, which is made a part
10 of this Resolution as a part thereof and a part herein.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Attachment 1, Attachment 2, Attachment 3,
12 Attachment 4 and Attachment 5 are made a part of this Resolution as a part thereof and a part
13 herein.
