If the original lot size was greater than or equal to twenty thousand (20,000) square feet but reduced in size due to a right-of-way taking or for a stormwater management pond, the minimum lot size may be reduced to no less than ten thousand (10,000) square feet. Such reduction is not permitted where an adjacent lot in the same ownership may be combined with the lot under twenty-thousand (20,000) square feet to reduce or eliminate the area deficiency.
