## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

Establishing a Task Force to Address Hospital Emergency Room Wait Times

For the purpose of establishing the task force on reducing hospital emergency room wait times to study best practices and make recommendations for reducing emergency room wait times; and generally relating to the task force on reducing emergency room wait times.

WHEREAS, there is a concern that wait times before patients receive treatment in hospital emergency rooms are untenable and are leading to dangerous consequences; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to identify the root causes of these wait times, how said wait times can be diminished and, if possible eliminated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that this task force must (1) identify root causes of wait times in emergency departments in the County, as specified; (2) study the regulatory environment, access and availability of health care services, and inpatient bed availability in other counties and states, as specified; (3) coordinate with other commissions and entities within the state examining issues related to workforce shortage and behavioral health capacity; (4) review studies and recommendations addressing workforce capacity issues; (5) conduct an analysis of reimbursement policies and the effect of those policies on hospital reimbursement; and (6) make recommendations, including legislative, regulatory, or other policy initiatives, regarding best practices for reducing emergency department wait times that should be implemented in the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County,

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1	Maryland, that the Hospital Emergency Room Wait Times Task Force shall be composed of		
2	seventeen members:		
3	1.	The Chair of the Board of Health, or their designee, who will serve as the Chair;	
4		and	
5	2.	Two representatives of a hospital located in Prince George's County, Maryland;	
6		and	
7	3.	A representative from Non-Profit organization located in Prince George's County;	
8		and	
9	4.	A representative from the Prince George's Fire/EMS Department; and	
10	5.	A representative from the Prince George's County Department of Health's	
11		Healthcare Action Coalition; and	
12	6.	A State Delegate or State Senator representing Prince George's County,	
13		Maryland; and	
14	7.	An emergency room physician practicing in Prince George's County, Maryland;	
15		and	
16	8.	An emergency room nurse practicing in Prince George's County, Maryland; and	
17	9.	Three (3) residents of Prince George's County, Maryland or three (3)	
18		representatives of organizations representing communities in Prince George's	
19		County, Maryland; and	
20	10.	A representative from SEIU Local 1199; and	
21	11.	A staff member of the Legislative Branch as directed by the County Chair of the	
22		Board of Health; and	
23	12.	One Registered Nurse employed in an Emergency Department who is a member	
24		of an employee organization that is the exclusive bargaining representative of	
25		health care workers; and	
26	13.	One Service Employee employed in an Emergency Department who is a member	
27		of an employee organization that is the exclusive bargaining representative of	
28		health care workers.	
29	14.	One representative of a healthcare clinic in Prince George's County, Maryland.	
30	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no member of the Hospital Emergency Room Wait		
31	Times Task Force shall receive compensation in exchange for their services rendered to this Task		
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Force; but they are entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations as provided by the County Budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hospital Emergency Room Wait Times Task Force shall begin within six (6) months of this resolution's adoption and end with the presentation of a final written report and a summary of its findings to the County Council within one (1) year of this resolution's adoption.
