PUBLIC SAFETY AND FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 3/6/97

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0, (In favor: Council Members Wilson, Esteppe, Gourdine, Maloney and Scott).

This Bill will amend the County's Classification Plan to assign an existing class of work to the new Family Connection Division, Department of Family Services' bargaining unit, represented by AFSCME Local 2735. The classes of work are being established at the same relative grade level and salary range as comparable classes of work in the General Schedule.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-25-1997.
