RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Super Bowl XLII (2008) - Taxing Authority Agency Assurance

For the purpose of exempting from all taxes, assessments or fees imposed by Prince George's County, Maryland on gross receipts from admission tickets to sporting, cultural or entertainment events during the Super Bowl Period including tax assessments or fees imposed on admission tickets to Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events and exempting the NFL or any of its Affiliates (including, without limitation, NFL Enterprises, LP, NFL Properties, LLC or NFL Productions) in the conduct of its "Super Bowl activities" from all payroll (unemployment and withholding), income and use taxes ordinarily imposed by Prince George's County, Maryland upon a successful bid by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee for Super Bowl XLII (2008).

WHEREAS, the National Football League (the "League") owns, produces and controls the annual professional football championship game known as the "Super Bowl", the largest national annual sporting event held in this country; and National Football League Properties, LLC ("NFLP" or, together with the League, the "NFL") owns, produces and controls the "NFL Experience," and along with other NFL Affiliates owns, produces and controls certain other events associated with the Super Bowl ("Official Events"); and

WHEREAS, FedExField (the "Stadium") is located at 1600 FedEx Way, Landover, Maryland 20785; and

WHEREAS, Prince George's County, Maryland is desirous of hosting Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events and has located within its jurisdiction the Stadium and proposed facilities for Official Events; and

WHEREAS, the National Football League will be engaged in the sale of admission tickets to Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events; and

WHEREAS, Prince George's County, Maryland has the authority to tax the sale of admission tickets to events within its jurisdiction.

SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that as requested by the National Football League, and as part of the formal bid of the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee with Prince George's County, Maryland to be designated as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008), with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, the governing body of Prince George's County, Maryland declares as follows:

- 1. Upon designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, and at all times thereafter, Prince George's County, Maryland guarantees that Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events shall be exempt from all taxes, assessments or fees imposed by Prince George's County, Maryland on gross receipts from admission tickets to sporting, cultural or entertainment events during the Super Bowl Period including tax assessments or fees imposed on admission tickets to Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events.
- 2. Upon designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, and at all times thereafter, Prince George's County, Maryland agrees that neither the NFL nor the two participating teams (the "Teams"), nor any director, officer, shareholder, agent, employee or other representative of the NFL or the Teams shall be held accountable for or incur any financial responsibility or liability of any kind or nature whatsoever, in connection with any Prince George's County, Maryland tax assessments on admission tickets to Super Bowl XLII (2008) or related Official Events.
- 3. As part of the consideration herein, Prince George's County, Maryland hereby warrants and agrees to exempt the NFL or any of its Affiliates (including, without limitation, NFL Enterprises, LP, NFL Properties, LLC or NFL Productions) in the conduct of its "Super Bowl activities" from all payroll (unemployment and withholding), income and use taxes ordinarily imposed by Prince George's County, Maryland. "Super Bowl activities" is defined to

mean any and all activities, including preparatory site visits in advance of the event; NFL sponsored events during the Super Bowl and activities following the event, carried out by the NFL, its personnel and other authorized NFL agents solely for the purpose of holding the Super Bowl.

Prince George's County, Maryland also warrants and agrees that to the extent the NFL or any of its affiliates already has filing requirements in Prince George's County, Maryland that the "Super Bowl activities" contemplated herein shall be treated as separate and distinct from those activities ordinarily carried on in Prince George's County, Maryland and shall not be considered for purposes of allocating or apportioning income or calculating payroll taxes.

The exemptions provided herein are not intended to extend to the NFL's use of employees or agents currently located in Prince George's County, Maryland or to those employees or agents hired from within Prince George's County, Maryland to assist in the production of the Super Bowl.

Prince George's County, Maryland further warrants and agrees to assist the NFL in its efforts to obtain similar exemptions from all payroll (unemployment and withholding), income and use taxes imposed by other taxing authorities.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of adoption and that Section 1 of this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of receipt of a successful bid by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee for Super Bowl XLII (2008). In the event that the designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland does not occur, the provisions of this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and of no further force and effect.
