REPORT: Committee Vote: Favorably, 9-0 (Council Members Oriadha, Dernoga, Watson, Olson, and Hawkins, Fisher, Blegay, Adam-Stafford, and Harrison)

The Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, convened on October 21, 2025, CB-104-2025, an act concerning enforcement and referral to the Board of Ethics, to require a mandatory review by the Prince George's County Board of Ethics for any person found in violation of Prince George's County Code, Subtitle 2, Section 2, Division 46, Community Inclusiveness.

This legislation would clarify that employees and staff of Prince George's County Government, Prince George's County Public Schools, and County employees will not engage with ICE on social media or in any other way for county purposes. It will also confirm the County government's encouragement that ICE is barred from accessing residents' information and that all county agencies and institutions are barred from doing so.

After a motion by Council Vice Chair Oriadha and a second by Council Member Harrison, the County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted favorably on CB-104-2025, 9-0.
