**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Prince George's County Street Vending Pilot Program

3 For the purpose of requiring the Department of Permitting, Inspection and Enforcement,  
4 Economic Development Corporation and Health Department to develop a regulatory program on  
5 certain streets in Prince George's County where street vending is allowed and a simplified and  
6 less cumbersome regulatory process while balancing legitimate health concerns for street foods.  
7 This pilot will develop a safe and regulated environment for street vending in Prince George's  
8 County.

10 **SUBTITLE 5. BUSINESSES AND LICENSES.**

11 Section 193.06

12 The Prince George's County Code

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
15 Maryland, that Section 193.06 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby  
16 added:

17 **SUBTITLE 5. BUSINESSES AND LICENSES.**

18 **DIVISION 12. PEDDLERS AND ITINERANT VENDORS.**

19 **Sec. 193.06. The Prince George's County Street Vending Pilot Program.**

20 (a) The Department of Permitting, Inspection and Enforcement, Economic Development  
21 Corporation and Health Department shall develop a pilot program on certain streets in Prince

George’s County where street vending is allowed and a simplified and less cumbersome regulatory process while balancing legitimate health concerns for street foods.

(b) The pilot program shall be called “The Prince George’s County Street Vending Pilot Program”.

(c) The County Council shall develop an oversight mechanism to monitor the progress of The Prince George’s County Street Vending Pilot Program.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
