**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Support for the Creative Industry

3 For the purpose of expressing support for motion pictures, visual arts, commercial productions,  
4 and all other creative industries to invest in Prince George's County.

5 WHEREAS, Maryland's Film Production Activity Tax Credit provides incentives to  
6 qualified film, television, and commercial production companies for eligible expenditures  
7 incurred within the state, thereby encouraging substantial investment in local economies; and

8 WHEREAS, Maryland's Film Production Activity Tax Credit can cover up to thirty percent  
9 (30%) of the direct costs of producing films or series; and

10 WHEREAS, the Film Production Activity Tax Credit has successfully attracted numerous  
11 productions to Maryland, stimulating economic growth, creating quality jobs, and enhancing  
12 local business revenues throughout the state; and

13 WHEREAS, Prince George's County is committed to working with the Maryland General  
14 Assembly to identify and establish additional tax and financial incentives to amplify the creative  
15 industry and support local industries within the County.

16 WHEREAS, Prince George's County, with its diverse landscapes, historical landmarks, and  
17 proximity to the nation's capital, offers unique filming locations and resources advantageous for  
18 various motion picture and television projects; and

19 WHEREAS, Prince George's County is committed to becoming a prominent filming  
20 destination and has proactively sought to foster a welcoming environment for the film industry,  
21 demonstrated by recent substantial investments such as MegaMind Media's acquisition and

1 development of property in Fairmont Heights; and

2 WHEREAS, the expansion of MegaMind Media in Fairmont Heights symbolizes a  
3 significant opportunity for economic revitalization, job creation, and infrastructural  
4 improvements within Prince George’s County; and

5 WHEREAS, increased production activity driven by film studios and creative enterprises  
6 can boost tourism, hospitality, construction, transportation, and other ancillary industries  
7 essential to the economic fabric of the County; and

8 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the broader cultural and economic benefits of  
9 positioning Prince George’s County as a strategic hub for film production, enhancing its regional  
10 and national profile; and

11 WHEREAS, the County Council is committed to collaborating with local partners such as  
12 the Prince George’s Arts and Humanities Council, Prince George’s County Economic  
13 Development Corporation, and Prince George’s Chamber of Commerce to identify and support  
14 further opportunities for creative community development projects; and

15 WHEREAS, the County Council is also committed to collaborating with all businesses and  
16 individuals that wish to bring creative industry projects to the County.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George’s  
18 County, Maryland, that the County Council expresses strong support for creative industries and  
19 production companies to view Prince George’s County as a safe haven for their investment,  
20 fostering mutual economic and cultural prosperity.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council encourages these businesses to  
22 utilize the Film Production Activity Tax Credit and invest within Prince George’s County.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council encourages Maryland’s General  
24 Assembly and Governor to continue their strong commitment to attract major motion picture and  
25 television productions to the County and the State.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Governor of  
27 Maryland, the Maryland General Assembly, Maryland Film Office, Prince George’s Arts and  
28 Humanities Council, Prince George’s County Economic Development Corporation, Prince  
29 George’s Chamber of Commerce, relevant stakeholders, and prospective motion picture studios  
30 and production companies to communicate Prince George’s County’s dedication to supporting  
31 and expanding its partnership with the creative industry.
