## PUBLIC HEARING ON POTENTIAL FIRST PHASE RESIDENTIAL AUTOMATED SPEED ENFORCEMENT SITES

The County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, hereby gives notice of a public hearing on the potential locations for the installation of speed monitoring systems prior to there installation.

The Prince George's County Council adopted CB-73-2021 (DR-2), pursuant to State law, to authorize the use of Speed Camera Monitoring Systems to regulate traffic in the County. Pursuant to Section 3 of CB-73-2022 (DR-2), the County Council shall hold at least one (1) public hearing to obtain public comment on potential locations for the installation of speed monitoring systems prior to
