BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

The Subdivision Regulations, Subtitle 24, have included a test for the adequacy of police facilities for many years. This test has been based on the adequacy of all of the County's police stations to accommodate the officers necessitated by a proposed development. Therefore, if the total square footage of all six District stations is deemed adequate for the current number of officers and the officers necessary for the proposed subdivision, based on standards in adopted Planning Board guidelines, adequacy is found. This legislation requires that the test be performed on the basis of Police Department District boundaries.
