What Services Are Being Offered?

Behavioral health services on the Doctors/Luminis Lanham Campus will provide local access to acute care services for patients in mental health and substance use disorder crisis. The building that will be used for Behavioral Health is proximal to the current Emergency Department. The facility will include:

1st Floor: Outpatient services

- Intensive Outpatient Treatment (IOP)
- Outpatient Mental Health Clinic
- Psychiatric Day Hospital/Partial Hospitalization Program
- Residential Crisis
- 6-Bay Walk-in Urgent Care

2nd Floor: Inpatient services

- 16 bed adult unit

Timeline

- Roof was taken off of the north section to be raised.
 - Roof was too low to meet code for behavioral health/clinical care.
- Projected opening – April is no longer feasible due to construction and supply chain issues. A lot of mitigating efforts are being considered. Now looking to open in the summer.
 - Outpatient – Summer 2022
 - Inpatient – December 2022
- The goal is to begin with a partial opening of the building – first floor.
- With limited labor availability and supplies, it makes it more difficult to complete things up to code and compliance in a timely manner.

Timeline (continued)

- Almost daily they are having to determine how to keep things moving despite limitations.
- Hard hat tours will begin in February. This can include media, CEX, etc.
- Setting up additional meetings to discuss clinical and operational planning.
- Have had to pull back with recruitment due to the unknown opening/official hiring dates.
- Exploring how to hire folks earlier to do some interim work at the other campuses.
