		MR. TEDESCO: Yes, thank you, Madam Examiner.
	Pursuant t	to Exhibit 56, premarked on your exhibit list, we

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did submit a letter on October 4th, requesting a continuance of this hearing to October 20th. We did confer with

People's Zoning Council with respect to that and also with

your office to clear that date. The basis for the

continuance is provided for in that letter. We would submit

on that and respectfully request your approval pursuant to that letter and the provisions provided therein for the continuance of this hearing to October 20th, understanding that there is somewhat of a time limit that day, but we will endeavor to make sure we adhere to that limitation.

But with that, we would respectfully request your approval of the continuance of this hearing to October 20th.

MS. MCNEIL: Okay. Mr. Tedesco, just because we're being recorded, I did read the exhibit, but the good

cause is that neither of your important witnesses were

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available today?

MR. TEDESCO: Yes, thank you, and I wasn't sure if

I needed to get into that level of detail, but yes, for the

were called out. One is traveling to Chicago and one is

traveling to South Carolina as we speak and are on a plane

and unable to even attend virtually and could not reschedule

those traveling obligations at the last minute. So with that we would request, that is the good cause basis for the request here today and would certainly appreciate your

approval of that.

MR. BROWN: I have no objection.

6	continued until October 20th. We're going to start just a
7	little earlier so I'm stating on the record at 9:00 a.m., if
8	that works for you all, in an abundance of caution because
9	we have another hearing at 1:30, and even though I don't
10	need to eat, all the staff should be allowed the
11	opportunity. So it's continued until then. Mr. Tedesco, if
12	you could put the new date on the signs for us, I would
13	appreciate that, October 20th. Okay.
