
FY 2022 RAISE Grant Application Overview

- In July 2021, Prince George's County Department of Parks and Recreation and Montgomery
 Parks applied for \$23 million in FY 2021 U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) RAISE
 discretionary grant program funds. The proposal included rehabilitation of existing trails and
 construction of new trails throughout the region, with a special emphasis on filling gaps in the
 trail network and improving outcomes for traditionally underserved communities.
- The FY 2021 application was highly rated by U.S. DOT staff during the technical evaluation and made it to the final round to be considered by the U.S. DOT Secretary, but ultimately it was not selected for funding. Both agencies intend to build upon the strengths of the previous application and apply for \$25 million in FY 2022 funds. As in FY 21, the regional office of the National Park Service will provide technical assistance for the application, including copywriting, GIS, and economic analysis. The deadline for applications is April 14, 2022.
- The District Department of Transportation will join the application team, further strengthening
 the regional aspect of the application with the construction of the Arboretum Bridge and
 Kenilworth South Park Trail.
- The proposed projects support economic development by facilitating bicycle and pedestrian
 travel and linking residents to employment and activity centers. It provides three new trail
 connections to Metrorail stations and two light rail stations and connects residents in
 Montgomery and Prince George's Counties to the Blue, Green and Red Metrorail lines and the
 future Purple Line corridor.
