**REPORT:** No Recommendation Vote 9-0: Council Members Hawkins, Burroughs, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Taveras, and Turner. Absent: Streeter.

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on April 26, 2022, and April 28, 2022, to consider CR-031-2022. CR-031-2022 is a resolution regarding approving certain FY 2023 multi-year contracts exceeding an aggregate of Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) for goods and services, as well as, multi-year personal service contracts exceeding an aggregate of One Hundred Thousand dollars (\$100,000).

Pursuant to Section 10-105 of County Code, the County Executive must submit a report listing all executory multiyear personal service contracts for the ensuing fiscal year exceeding an aggregate of One Hundred Thousand dollars (\$100,000) per contractor, and all other executory multiyear contracts exceeding an aggregate of Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$500,000) for public review, comment, and approval action by the County Council.

During the Committee meetings concerns were raised about the waivers and the need to make sure the County considered local vendors. Glenn Morehead, Deputy Director Office of Central Services provided additional information about the Contracts in question. Concerns were raised about the Tree Trimming Contract as it relates to local vendors.

The Office of Law finds CR-031-2022 to be in proper legislative form with no impediments to its adoption.

After a very robust discussion about the need for the County to reach out to our local community for the procurement of goods and services, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, reported CR-031-2022 out with no recommendation, 9-0.
