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**REPORT:** Favorable 4-0: Council Members Burroughs, Franklin, Ivey, and Turner. Absent Streeter.

The Prince Georges County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on May 12, 2022, to consider CB-031-2022. CB-031-2022 will approve the collective bargaining by and between Prince George's County, Maryland (the County) and Council 67, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and its affiliated Locals 2462, 2735, 3389, and 1170 (AFSCME). This new labor agreement (the Agreement) covers Fiscal Years 2023 and 2024.

Although the Agreement carries forward many of the terms and conditions of the County's previous labor agreement with AFSCME, the new Agreement contains several modifications. These modifications are listed for Council in the enclosed Settlement Summary.

During the Committee meeting, Angela Beasley, Deputy Director, Office of Human Resources Management, provided a wage increase overview. This Agreement includes cost-of-living allowances and merits for fiscal years 2023 and 2024.

The Office of Law reports CB-031-2022 to be in proper legislative form with no impediments to its enactment.

The Policy group reports that CB-031-2022 will have a negative impact on the County in that this Agreement will cost \$17,022,814 over the Fiscal Years 2023 and 2024.

After discussion, the Prince Georges County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee voted CB-031-2022 out favorably, 4-0.
