For the purpose of increasing	and adding fines and penalties for violating certain parking laws,
including laws regarding star	nding or parking at bus stops, unregistered vehicles and trailers,
expired registration stickers;	reserved parking spaces, meter spaces, damaging parking meters,
and public parking facilities;	and authorizing immobilization and/or impoundments without prior
notice to owners of vehicles	with five or more unpaid traffic and/or parking violations.

4	DIVISION 8 PARKING REGULATIONS.
5	Sec. 26-127. Standing or parking restricted at bus stops.
6	(a) The Director is hereby authorized to approve or disapprove the location of bus stops or
7	rescind or modify any prior approval heretofore given.
8	(b) No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle other than a bus within thirty (30) feet of a
9	bus stop, except that a driver of a passenger vehicle may temporarily stop therein for the purpose
10	of, and while actually engaged in, loading or unloading passengers when such stopping does not
11	interfere with any bus waiting to enter or about to enter such zone. Any person issued a citation
12	for a violation of this Subsection shall be subject to a fine of [Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)] Fifty
13	Dollars (\$50.00) for each violation.

15	Sec. 26-127.01. Parking of unregistered motor vehicles or unregistered trailers; expired
16	registration stickers.
17	(a) A vehicle for which two registration plates are required, one plate shall be attached on
18	the front and the other on the rear of the vehicle
19	(b) No person shall park any unregistered motor vehicle or unregistered trailer upon the
20	highways, roads, streets, or other public property in the County at any time.
21	(c) No person shall park any motor vehicle or trailer displaying expired registration
22	stickers upon the highways, roads, streets, or other public property in the County at any time.
23	(d) [(c)] Any person issued a citation for violation of this Section shall be subject to a fine
24	of [Sixty Dollars (\$60.00)] One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each violation.

26	Sec. 26-129. Unauthorized use of reserved parking spaces; impounding; penalty.
27	(a) No person shall park, store, or leave any vehicle of any kind, whether attended or not,
28	and no owner of any vehicle of any kind shall allow, permit, or suffer any vehicle to be parked,
29	stored, or left, whether attended or not, upon any property owned or leased by the County and
30	used for parking purposes, including access and egress roadways, without the consent of the
31	County Executive.

1	(b) Any vehicle found parked in a reserved parking space designated as provided in
2	Section 26-128, whose owner or driver is not authorized to park in the space, may be impounded
3	by the Police Department, or the Revenue Authority, or County work force. The impoundment of
4	the vehicle shall be done pursuant to Division 18 of this Subtitle.
5	(c) Any person issued a citation for violation of this Section shall be subject to a fine of
6	[Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)] Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) for each violation.

8	Sec. 26-132 Use of parking meters; impounding; penalty.
9	(a) No person shall park, store, or leave any vehicle of any kind, whether attended or not,
10	and no owner of any vehicle shall allow, permit, or suffer the vehicle to be parked, stored, or left,
11	whether attended or not, upon any property upon which have been erected parking meters by the
12	Director, except in strict conformance with the designated use, time, and other conditions
13	appearing on or about any parking meters erected thereon.
14	(b) Any vehicle found parked, stored, or left in violation of the conditions found on or
15	about any parking meter may be impounded by the Police Department or the Revenue Authority,
16	or any County work force. The impoundment of the vehicle shall be done pursuant to Division
17	18 of Subtitle 26 of this Code.
18	(c) Any person issued a citation for a violation of this Section shall be subject to a fine of
19	not more than [Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00)] Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) for each offense.

21	Sec. 26-133 Damaging parking meters or signs.
22	(a) No person shall willfully damage, destroy, or tamper with any parking meter, sign, or
23	writing erected pursuant to this Division.
24	(b) Any person violating this Section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon
25	conviction, shall be subject to a fine not exceeding [Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)] One Hundred
26	Dollars (\$100) for each offense.

9	SECTION 2. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
10	Maryland, that Section 26-127.05 of the Prince George's County Code be and is hereby added:
11	
12	SUBTITLE 26. VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC.
13	DIVISION 8 PARKING REGULATIONS.
14	Sec. 26-127.05. Reserved parking for charging electric vehicles.
15	(a) No person shall stand or park a vehicle in any stall or parking space on public or
16	private property which is designated for charging an electric vehicle with the proper signs posted
17	in conformance with the most recent edition of the State of Maryland Manual on Uniform Traffic
18	Control Devices for Streets and Highways, unless said vehicle is connected for electric charging
19	purposes.
20	(b) Any person issued a citation for a violation of this Section shall be subject to a fine of
21	One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each violation.
22	(c) The provisions of Section 26-163.01 shall not be subject to the penalty imposed under
23	this Section.
24	SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
25	declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
26	sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
27	competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
28	words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
29	Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
30	invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
31	or section.

1	SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
2	calendar days after it becomes law.
